Show rules

- 1. Entrants must be resident in Bubbenhall, or have a resident vouch for them as a friend or relative.
- 2. Entries to be staged at the time specified on the Show day. No exceptions will be made.
- 3. All exhibits must be grown/made by the exhibitor, unless otherwise stated in the rules.
- 4. Entry is free in all sections.
- 5. Exhibitors must bring their own material for staging their exhibits plates, trays, vases etc.
- 6. All quantities and sizes in the schedule are to be strictly adhered to.
- 7. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 8. Judging will commence at 12.30 prompt behind closed doors. The judges' decisions are final.
- 9. No exhibits or award certificates are to be removed until after the viewing time specified above.

- 10. At the end of the viewing time specified above, exhibits in classes 25, 26, all handicrafts classes, and all junior section exhibits may be removed by the exhibitors. Refer to rules below regarding the retrieval of exhibits in classes 49 and 50. All other exhibits will be retained and may be sold at auction to raise funds for a cause nominated by the Village Hall Committee. Exhibitors shall have no claim to auction funds.
- 11. Trophy winners may retain the trophy for the year and have their name and date engraved on the trophy at their own cost. If taken by a winner, trophies must be returned in a clean and undamaged condition to the Village Hall Committee by 31 May in the year following the show. Anyone taking a trophy will be required to leave their name, address, telephone number and email address.
- 12. All photographs must be taken by the exhibitor. Photographs may be in colour or in black and white, and should be presented unframed. Photographs should not exceed 18cm x 13cm. Photographs may be temporarily retained by the committee to be reproduced and may be used in connection with the production of a Bubbenhall Village calendar, but exhibitors may subsequently collect their entry once advised by the committee that reproduction is complete. Please ensure your name and address is printed clearly on the reverse of the photograph.
- 13. All paintings or drawings must be created by the exhibitor. Any medium is acceptable on paper or canvas and should be presented unframed. Paintings or drawings should not exceed 30 cm x 45 cm. Paintings and drawings may be temporarily retained by the committee to be reproduced and may be used in connection with the production of a Bubbenhall Village calendar, but exhibitors may subsequently collect their entry once advised by the committee that reproduction is complete. Please ensure your name and address is printed clearly on the reverse of the art.
- 14. The organisers accept no responsibility for loss or damage to property howsoever caused.
